Sunday's Reflection

In today's Gospel we experience Jesus giving authority to carry out His work to the Apostles, and how their faith in Him leads to good works. St. Francis de Sales notes:

A living faith produces many great and good works. However, we see that strong and healthy people must often be stirred up to put their strength and skill to proper use. The hand must lead them to their work. While a soul that is heavily burdened has the power to believe and hope in God's love, it does not have the strength to see clearly if it does. Its distress has such a hold on it. Yet, our Savior never lets us go out on the road alone. The Spirit of Jesus is always with us, urging us on and appealing to our hearts and driving them forward so as to use well the holy love He places in us.

A tender mother leads along her little child, helps him and holds him up if she sees a need for it. Now she lets him take a few steps by himself in places that are very level and not too difficult. Then she takes him by the hand and holds him steady. At times she takes him up in her arms and carries him. It is also the way that our Savior takes constant care to lead forward His children. He enables them to walk before Him. He holds their hand in difficulties. Therefore, when all things fail us, when our distress is at its height, our abandonment into the hands of our Savior cannot fail us. He will carry us along in hardships that He sees as being unbearable to us if we let Him.

In many ways, God's care preserves those who have faith in the teachings of Jesus. Our entire good consists not only in accepting the truth of God's word, but also in persevering in it. Hence, we ought to have great courage and trust that God will assist us in all that we do for God's glory. Let us rouse our faith. Give it life in believing fully in God's love and care for us. Then all our works will bear fruit like those of the Apostles.

Reflexión Semanal

En el Evangelio de hoy experimentamos a Jesús dando autoridad a los Apóstoles para llevar a cabo Su obra, y cómo su fe en Él conduce a buenas obras. San Francisco de Sales señala:

Una fe viva produce muchas obras grandes y buenas. Sin embargo, vemos que a menudo hay que incitar a las personas fuertes y sanas a que pongan en práctica su fuerza y sus habilidades. La mano debe conducirlos a su trabajo. Si bien un alma que está pesadamente agobiada tiene el poder de creer y esperar en el amor de Dios, no tiene la fuerza para ver claramente si es así. Su angustia tiene tal poder sobre él. Sin embargo, nuestro Salvador nunca nos deja salir solos al camino. El Espíritu de Jesús está siempre con nosotros, impulsándonos y apelando a nuestro corazón e impulsándolo a utilizar bien el amor santo que Él deposita en nosotros.

Una tierna madre acompaña a su pequeño, lo ayuda y lo sostiene mientras lo necesita. Ahora le deja dar algunos pasos solo en lugares muy llanos y no demasiado difíciles. Luego lo toma de la mano y lo mantiene firme. A veces lo toma en brazos y lo carga. También es la forma en que nuestro Salvador se preocupa constantemente de sacar adelante a Sus hijos. Él les permite caminar delante de Él. Él les toma la mano en las dificultades. Por lo tanto, cuando todo nos falla, cuando nuestra angustia está en su punto máximo, nuestro abandono en manos de nuestro Salvador no puede fallarnos. Él nos llevará a través de dificultades que considera insostenibles para nosotros si se lo permitimos.

En muchos sentidos, el cuidado de Dios preserva a quienes tienen fe en las enseñanzas de Jesús. Todo nuestro bien consiste no sólo en aceptar la verdad de la palabra de Dios, sino también en perseverar en ella. Por lo tanto, debemos tener gran valor y confiar en que Dios nos ayudará en todo lo que hagamos para su gloria. Despertemos nuestra fe. Dale vida creyendo plenamente en el amor y el cuidado de Dios por nosotros. Entonces todas nuestras obras darán frutos como las de los Apóstoles.

Parish Registration: Why is it important to register at my parish? Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a particular church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses, Confessions, and devotions are planned and scheduled. Registration shows that you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining certificates, and getting contribution statements for taxes. You will also receive a packet of envelopes to place your regular contributions. This is important if you want to receive a year-end statement from the parish for income tax purposes. If you do not wish to receive weekly contribution envelopes, this should not be a reason not to register. **Just let the secretary know, and envelopes will not be ordered.**

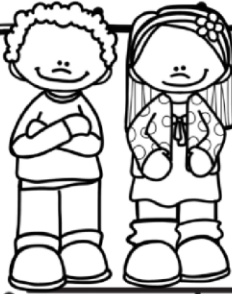
